Our curriculum focus this term in Humanities is **Geography**.

Children will be analysing data from land use and explain related and know how to use 4 and 6 figure references.

In maths, we are starting off with place value, where children will be learning to read, write, order and compare numbers to at least up to 10 million. They will move onto multiplying and dividing numbers by 10, 100 and 1,000.

Children will also be learning how to choose effective mental strategies for their calculations. They then tackle increasingly complex problems with the four operations. Also, children a variety of fractions skills building on knowledge from Year 5. They have an exciting term ahead!

Children will be expected to continue practising their times tables, which will help them in many areas of maths. Times

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
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Stormbreaker by Anthony
